The Program awards up to 27 credit hours of advanced standing to BSW graduates that meet the following conditions:

- 1. Degree granted from a CSWE accredited program within the last five years.
- 2. A graduation GPA of at least 3.00
- 3. Social Work major passed with a grade of A or B.
- 4. Field Practice courses passed with a grade of A.

If all conditions are met, an evaluation of the major coursework is conducted. For the MSW advanced standing, up to 21 credits will be granted for the foundation courses of Social Work major, approved with A or B. Another 6 credits will be granted for generalist practice only if the candidate had a grade of A in the supervised practice at the bachelor's level. The granting of the baccalaureate degree must be no older than five years or less. The following courses may be granted advanced standing:
